2024 POOL RULES

- 1. A seasonal pool pass per person is required to enter the pool area. Guest of seasonal pass holders can purchase a daily pass on deck.
- 2. Children under the age of 12 must have a parent, legal guardian or an adult (18 years old), actively supervising them at all times
- 3. No running, pushing, dunking, prolonged underwater breath holding, or other horseplay in or out of the pool.
- 4. Alcoholic beverages or glass containers are prohibited on the deck. No smoking or vaping on or near the pool deck.
- 5. All coolers, bags, and backpacks are subject to inspection.
- 6. Lifeguards must always be obeyed. Failure to comply with pool rules, whether written or verbal, may result in removal from the pool and/or revocation of membership.
- 7. Children not potty trained must wear a swim diaper and/or tight-fitting rubber or plastic pants.
- 8. No pets, skateboards, or bicycles are allowed on pool deck.
- 9. No diving. Only pool toys of soft material are allowed on the pool deck and in the pool.
- 10. During the lifeguard break everyone under the age of 18 is required to be out of the water completely and off the steps. All Lifeguards must take a 10-minute break every hour on the hour.
- 11. Wading/Baby pool is limited to children 5 and under, accompanied by an adult. No floats of any kind in wading pool.
- 12. Feature pool (mushroom) is an active area and adult supervision is required of all children. No floats of any kind in feature pool. Pool is closed during required Lifeguard break.
- 13. Main pool is open to all ages. Only donut floats, pool noodles, and swim vests, are allowed. Swimmers must always obey lifeguards in the pool and on the deck.
- 14. Original pool. This pool does not have a lifeguard Monday thru Friday from 10 am to 3pm. No one under the age of 18 is allowed in this pool if a lifeguard is not in the chair. A float under 36 inches can be used in this pool during the specific hours of Monday Friday, 10am to 3pm. After 3 pm all floats must be removed.

UNSCHEDULED CLOSING: During inclement weather, the pool is closed at the discretion of Lifeguards or Pool Management. All persons must leave the pool and deck at the first clear sound of thunder or the first visible lightning. Wait 30 minutes after the last clear and distinct sound of thunder to resume activities. Failure to clear the deck at the Lifeguards whistle and announcement is considered a violation. Physical confrontations or verbally challenging lifeguard will result in immediate loss of membership.

The pools may be closed periodically if operating difficulties or repair service needs arise.

Diarrhea or fecal matter in the pool is a high-risk event for contamination caused by Cryptosporidium and can cause the pool to be closed for an <u>extended number of days</u> while the pool is treated, and chemicals stabilized.

Violators of any pool rule will be required to leave the pool area. Repeated violations result in the party being ejected from the pool area for the season. Membership will be forfeited for the remainder of the season. Failure to leave the pool area is considered trespassing.
